- Discussion on the mice problem at the animal shelter. Pruser indicated that she went out to the facility approximately 2 weeks with the maintenance supervisor and noted that there was food all over and not stored properly and noticed the mice activity. She checked last month and stated that the situation was a little better, but that food is still not stored in the containers. If the shelter has too much food for their use it should be donated to other agencies. The shelter needs to have more cleaning in general. This has been addressed with the staff.
